

SUMMER UNIFORM

Boys: I-XII

TROUSERS

- 1a. (I-V) Green self-design fabric short trousers without straps, two side pockets and school prescribed piping on the pocket edges. Back pockets if student wishes. Shorts should not be more than 2" above the knees.
- 1b. (From 1st August to 31st October) (I-V) Green self-design fabric long trousers not baggy pants, with side pockets and school prescribed piping on the pockets One back pocket if the student wishes. Not more than <u>16"</u> in width at the bottom. (**No flaps on the pocket**).
- 1c. (From 1st August to 31st October) (VI-XII) Green self-design fabric long trousers not baggy pants, with side pockets and school prescribed piping on the pockets. One back pocket if the student wishes. Not more than 20" in width at the bottom. (No flaps on the pocket).

SHIRT

- 2a. (I-XII) Green and Yellow Checks short sleeved shirt with one pocket on the left with school monogram. (**Shoulder pads are not allowed**).
- 2b. (From 1st August to 31st October) (I-XII) Green and Yellow Checks long sleeved shirt with one pocket on the left with school monogram and green trousers.

SOCKS

- 3. Prescribed green colour school socks with school name and two green lines.
- 4. Prescribed White colour school socks with school name and house colour lines.

SHOES

- 5. (I-V) Plain Back Velcro shoes (high-heeled shoes are not allowed)
- 6. (VI-XII) Plain black leather shoes with laces. (high-heeled shoes are not allowed)

BELT/MONOGRAM

- Prescribed School belt with monogram engraved on the metal and around.
- 8. Cloth monogram stitched on the pocket of the shirt.

SCHOOL BAG

9. **(Up to Std. X)** A canvas cloth green school bag with piping, school name and monogram.

Girls: I-XII

SKIRT

- 1a. (I-III) Green self-design fabric Undivided skirt up to the knees with green straps and prescribed school design. Prescribed green colour bloomers.
- 1b. (IV-XII) Green self-design fabric Divided skirt up to the knees with green straps and prescribed school design. Prescribed green colour cycling shorts.

SHIRT

- 2a (I-XII) Green and Yellow Checks short sleeved shirt with one pocket on the left with school monogram. (Shoulder pads are not allowed)
- 2b. **(From 1st August to 31st October)** (I-XII) Green and Yellow Checks long sleeved shirt with one pocket on the left with school monogram.

TROUSERS

3. **(From 1st August to 31st October)** (**I-XII**) Green self-design fabric long trousers, not baggy pants, with side pockets and school prescribed piping on the pockets. One back pocket if the student wishes. **No flaps on the pocket**

SOCKS

- 4. Prescribed green colour school socks with School name and two green lines.
- 5. Prescribed White colour school socks with School name and house color lines.

SHOES

- 6. (I V) Plain back Velcro shoes (high heeled shoes are not allowed)
- 7. (VI XII) Plain black leather shoes with strap and buckle. (high heeled shoes are not allowed)

BELT

8. Prescribed school belt with monogram engraved on the metal and around.

SCHOOL MONOGRAM

9. Cloth monogram stitched on the pocket of the shirt.

RIBBONS

10. Green / white ribbons or hairband with 1.5 inches in width and 2 meters' length and ordinary black hair pins.

SCHOOL BAG

11. **(Up to Std. X)** A canvas cloth green school bag with piping, school name and monogram.

WINTER UNIFORM

(To be used from 1st November onwards)

Boys: I-XII

TROUSERS

- 1. (I-V) Brown coloured long woollen trousers with side pockets. No straps and not more than 16" in width at the bottom. (No flaps on the pocket and no baggy pants allowed)
- 2. (VI-XII) Brown coloured long woollen trousers with side pockets No. straps and not more than 20" in width at the bottom. (No flaps on the pocket and no baggy pants allowed)

SHIRT

3. (I-XII) Plain white long-sleeved shirt with cloth monogram stitched on the pocket to the left. (Shoulder pads not allowed)

SCHOOL BLAZER

4. School blazer with school monogram on the left and prescribed brown piping at the edges. (Single breast)

SWEATER

5. V. Neck Olive Green Sleeveless Sweater with two white lines at the neckline, arms and waistline.

SHOES

- 6. (I-V) Plain black Velcro shoes. (high -heeled shoes are not allowed)
- 7. (VI-XII) Plain black leather shoes with laces. high heeled shoes are not allowed)

SOCKS

8. Prescribed Brown colour school socks with school name and two white lines.

BELTS

9. Prescribed School belt with monogram engraved on the metal and around.

TIE/MUFFLER

- 10. (I-III) School Tie with cords and monogram
- 11. (IV-XII) School Tie with monogram
- 12. Muffler-Brown colour only.

SCHOOL BAG

13 (Up to Std. X) A canvas cloth green school bag with piping, school name and monogram.

Girls: I-XII

TROUSERS

- 1. (I-V) Brown coloured long woollen trousers with side pockets. No straps and not more than 16" in width at the bottom. (No flaps on the pocket and no baggy pants allowed)
- 2. (VI-XII) Brown coloured long woollen trousers with side pockets. No straps and not more than 20" in width at the bottom. (No flaps on the pocket and no baggy pants allowed)

SHIRT

3. (I-XII) Plain white long-sleeved shirt with cloth monogram stitched on the pocket to the left. (Shoulder pads not allowed)

SCHOOL BLAZER

4. Single breasted blazer with school monogram on the left and prescribed brown piping at the edges.

SWEATER

5. V. Neck Olive Green Sleeveless Sweater with two white lines at the neckline, arms and waistline.

SHOES

- 6. (I-V) Plain black Velcro shoes. (high heeled shoes are not allowed)
- 7. (VI XII) Plain black leather shoes with strap and buckle. (high-heeled shoes are not allowed)

SOCKS

8. Prescribed Brown colour school socks with school name and two white lines.

BELT

9. Prescribed School belt with monogram engraved on the metal and around.

TIE

- 11. (IV-XII) School Tie with monogram

HAIRBAND/RIBBONS

12. Hairband with 1.5 inches in width or brown ribbon of 2 metre length and ordinary black hair pins.

SCARF

13. Scarf-Brown colour only.

SCHOOL BAG

14. **(Up to Std. X)** A canvas cloth green school bag with piping, school name and monogram.

P.T. Uniform on Tuesdays and Fridays in Summer

Boys I-XII

- 1. (I V) Long White trousers with side pocket (not more than 16" width at the bottom), no flaps on the pocket. No baggy pants allowed.
- 2. (VI- XII) Long White trousers with side pocket (not more than 20" width at the bottom), no flaps on the pocket. No baggy pants allowed.
- 3. (I-XII) Short Sleeved white shirt with cloth monogram stitched on the pocket on the left side on Tuesdays and House T Shirt on Fridays.
- 4. (IV) Plain White Velcro shoes. (high-heeled shoes are not allowed)
- 5. (VI-XII) Plain White canvas shoes. (high-heeled shoes are not allowed)
- 6. Prescribed White colour school socks with School name and house colour lines.
- 7. Prescribed School belt with monogram engraved on the metal around.

Girls I-XII

- 1. (I-V) Long White trousers with side pocket (not more than 16" width at the bottom), no flaps on the pocket. No baggy pants allowed
- 2. (V-XII) Long White trousers with side pocket (not more than 20" width at the bottom), no flaps on the pocket. No baggy pants allowed
- 3. (I-XII) Short Sleeved white shirt with cloth monogram stitched on the pocket on the left side on Tuesdays and **House T Shirt on Fridays.**
- 4. (I-V) Plain White Velcro shoes. (high-heeled shoes are not allowed)
- 5. (VI-XII) Plain White canvas shoes. (high-heeled shoes are not allowed)
- 6. Prescribed White colour school socks with name and house colour lines.
- 7. Prescribed School belt with monogram engraved on the metal and around.
- 8. White ribbons 1.5 inches in width and 2 metre length or white hairband and ordinary black hair pins.

P.T. Uniform on Tuesdays and Fridays in Winter

Boys I-XII

- 1. (I V) Long White trousers with side pocket (not more than 16" width at the bottom), no flaps on the pocket. No baggy pants allowed.
- 2. (VI- XII) Long White trousers with side pocket (not more than 20" width at the bottom), no flaps on the pocket. No baggy pants allowed.
- 3. (I-XII) Long Sleeved white shirt with cloth monogram stitched on the pocket on the left side. (Shoulder pads not allowed)
- 4. V. Neck Olive Green Sleeveless Sweater with two white lines at the neckline, arms and waistline.
- 5. School Blazer on Tuesdays.
- 6. School House Jacket on Fridays
- 7. (I-V) Plain White Velcro shoes. (high-heeled shoes are not allowed)
- 8. (VI-XII) Plain White canvas shoes. (high-heeled shoes are not allowed)
- Prescribed White colour school socks with School name and house colour lines.

Girls I-XII

- 2. (VI- XII) Long white trousers with side pocket (not more than 20" width at the bottom), no flaps on the pocket. No baggy pants allowed.
- 3. (I XII) Long Sleeved white shirt with cloth monogram stitched on the pocket on the left side. (Shoulder pads not allowed)
- 4. V. Neck Olive green Sleeveless Sweater.
- 5. School Blazer on Tuesdays.
- 6. School House Jacket on Fridays.
- 7. (I-V) Plain White Velcro shoes (high-heeled shoes are not allowed)
- 8. (VI-XII) Plain white canvas shoes. (high-heeled shoes are not allowed)
- 9. Prescribed white colour school socks with school name and house colour lines
- 10. Prescribed School belt with monogram engraved on the metal and around.
- 11. White ribbons 1.5 inches in width and 2 metre length or white hairband and ordinary black hair pins.
